

Man on the Moon

Among the signature human accomplishments of the 20th Century are the explorations of space, and none of those is as defining as the Apollo 11 manned moon landing. Launched on July 16, 1969, the space capsule, containing astronauts Edwin “Buzz” Aldrin, Neil Armstrong, and Michael Collins, entered lunar orbit 75 hours and 50 minutes after liftoff. The lunar module (LM) containing Armstrong and Aldrin touched down on the lunar surface 102 hours, 45 minutes, and 40 seconds after liftoff.

Armstrong was the first to exit the LM and release an equipment package, including a camera that recorded humankind's first step on the Moon at 109:24:19. The photo showing his descent to the lunar surface was commemorated with a 10 cent US airmail stamp (Scott C76), issued September 9, and shown on the cover of this program.



Armstrong's footprint on lunar soil is shown on the stamp at left (Scott 3188c) issued in 1999 from the Celebrate the Century series.

Many more stamps have been issued by the US and by other countries to commemorate the first manned moon landing. A 2019 50th anniversary stamp has not yet been announced by USPS.

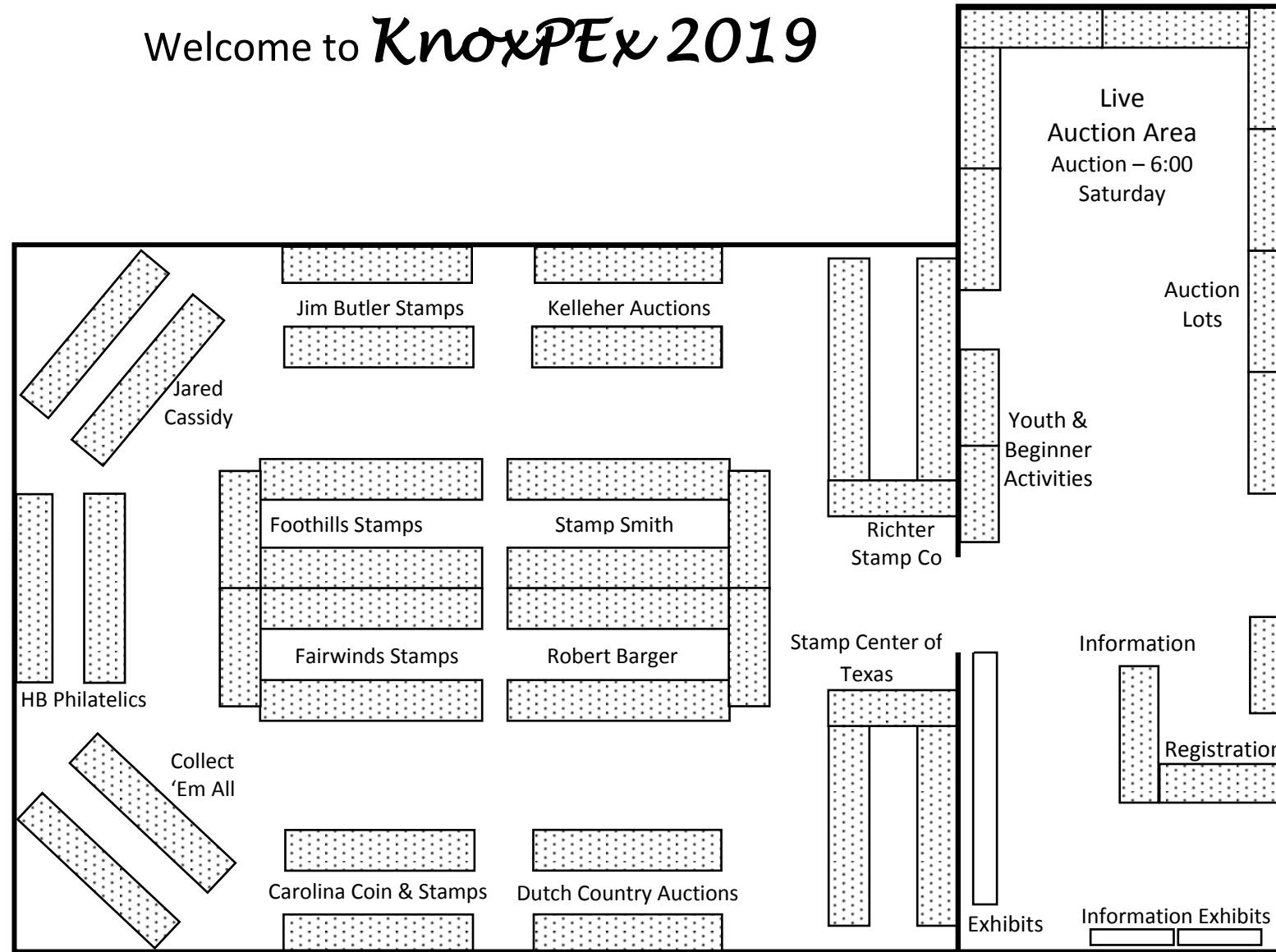
Each spring, *KnoxPEX* features a theme that highlights the ways in which postage stamps and their uses have illustrated important historical events.
