The American Museum of Science & Energy, located in Oak Ridge, Tennessee, is one of three sites that commemorate the “Secret City” and its role in the Manhattan Project that led to the development of the atomic bomb. The museum was founded in 1949 at the time that the “Secret City” of Oak Ridge was no longer a classified site. Now, the Manhattan Project National Historical Park (www.nps.gov/mapr/index.htm), the Oak Ridge History Museum (<https://oakridgeheritage.com>), and the American Museum of Science & Energy (<https://amse.org>) show the technical and human history of the Manhattan Project and the Secret City. AMSE also contains exhibits related to other forms of energy, looking to the future.
