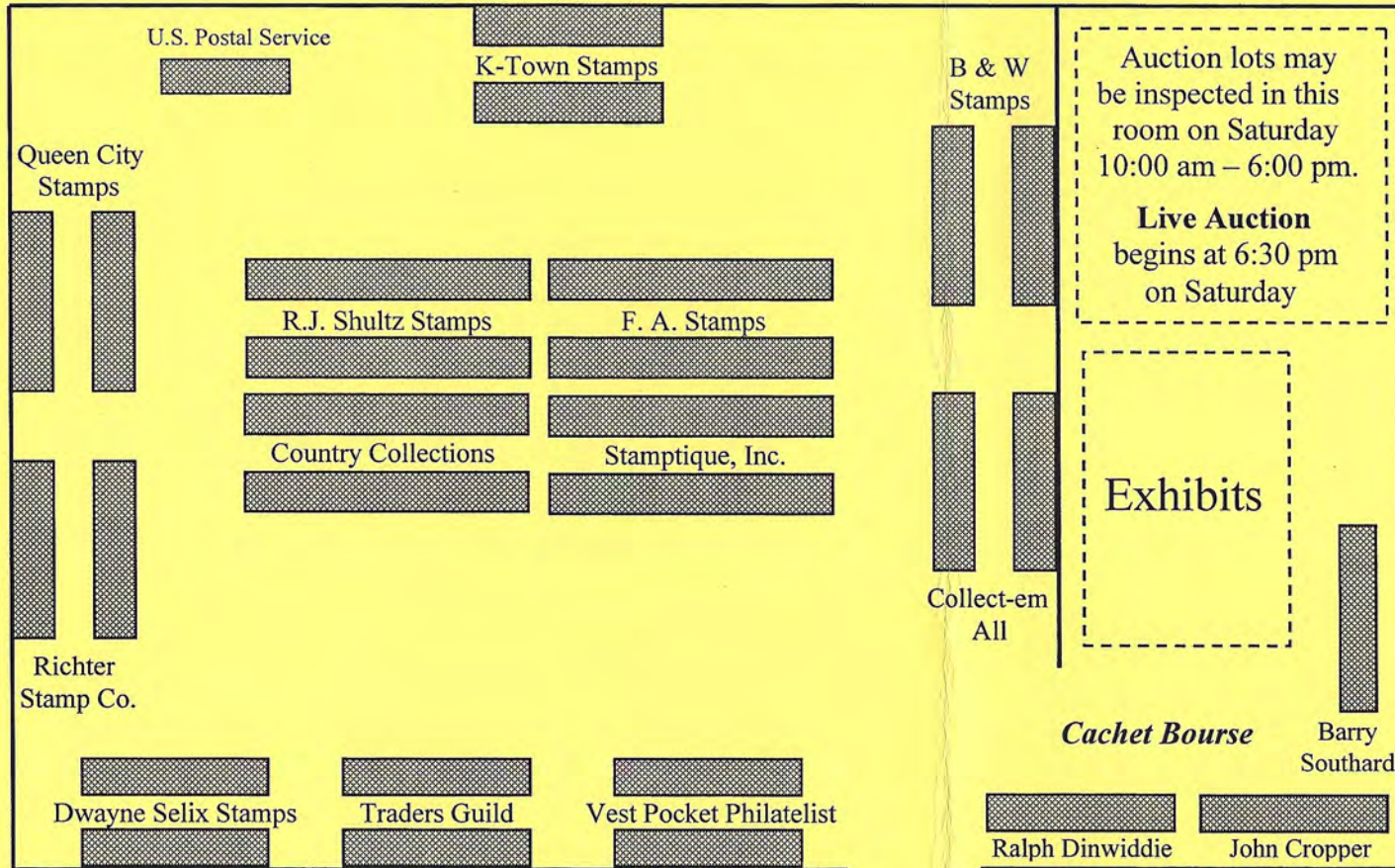

The 50th Anniversary of Rock & Roll Music

Music dates back to prehistoric times, and many cultures can claim the origin of a particular music style. Although some believe that the first Rock & Roll song was *Rock Around The Clock*, this distinctive all-American style really took off in 1956 with Elvis Presley's top 40 hit *Heartbreak Hotel*. He had 16 more songs on the charts that year, including *Don't Be Cruel* and *Hound Dog*.

Rock & Roll Philately

Rock and Roll music has been commemorated in 1993 (Scott 2721, 2724, 2725, 2727, 2729 and in corresponding booklet stamps 2731, 2732, 2734, 2736) by the "American Music" series and in 1999 with the "Celebrate the Century" series (Scott 3187m).
