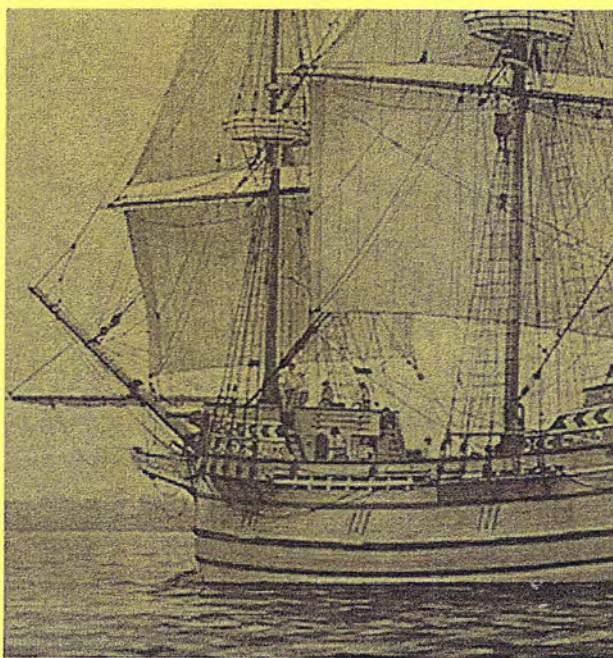

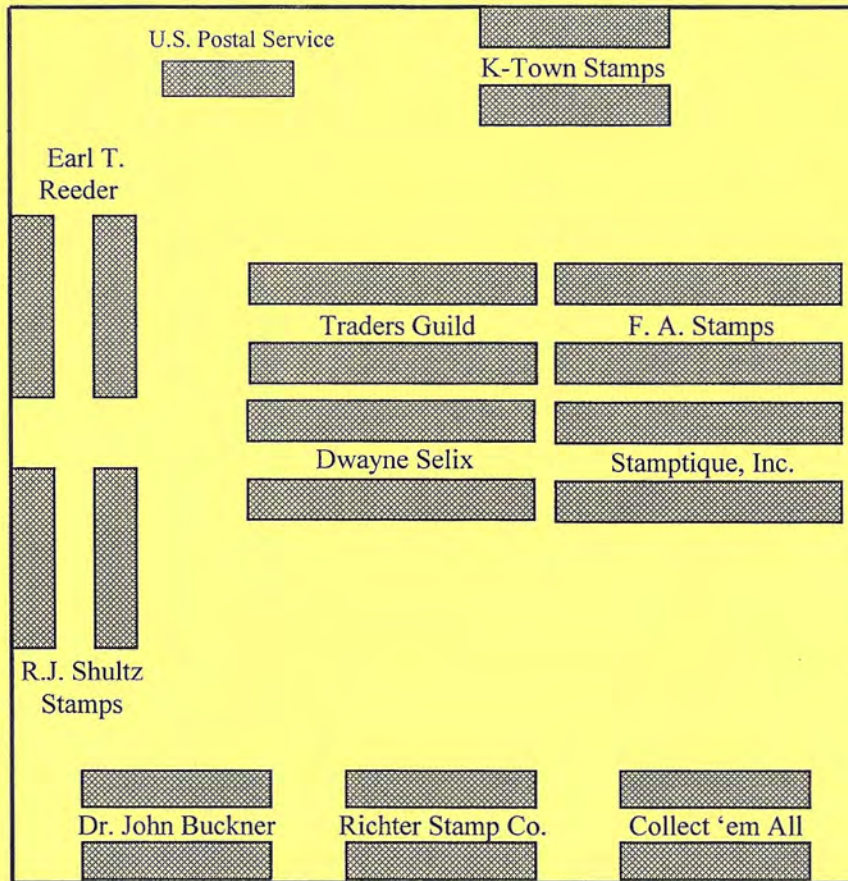

## The 400<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Jamestown Voyage

On December 20, 1606, three ships, the HMS *Susan Constant*, *Godspeed*, and *Discovery* departed London to attempt to establish a permanent English colony in the New World. Following a two week delay off the English coast, the ships headed south and west, arriving in the West Indies in February, and visiting the island of Nevis on March 3-4, 1607. Heading north, they arrived off the coast of present day Virginia on March 26, and after stopping at various sites, made a permanent landing on Jamestown Island on May 14.

## Jamestown Philately

The founding of Jamestown was commemorated 100 years ago in 1907 with a series of three commemorative stamps (Scott 328-330) showing Captain John Smith, the landing at Jamestown, and the Indian princess, Pocahontas. A souvenir sheet and stamp will be issued in May, 2007.
