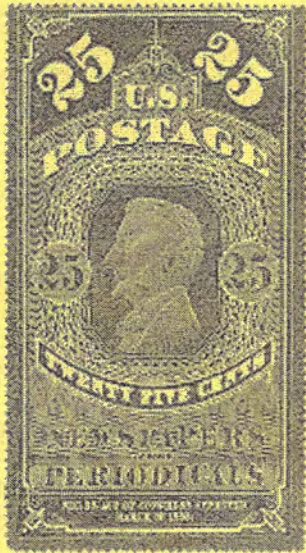

# Lincoln on Stamps

Abraham Lincoln, our 16<sup>th</sup> President, is the third most commonly illustrated person on U.S. postage stamps, after George Washington and Benjamin Franklin. However, he is the American who has appeared most frequently on stamps around the world.

The first stamp to feature Lincoln was the 25 cent newspaper tax stamp issued in 1865, and some authorities believe that it may have been issued prior to Lincoln's death.



Beautiful stamps of more familiar design have been issued over nearly 150 years.

Each spring, *KnoxpeX* features a theme that highlights the ways in which postage stamps and their uses have illustrated important historical events.

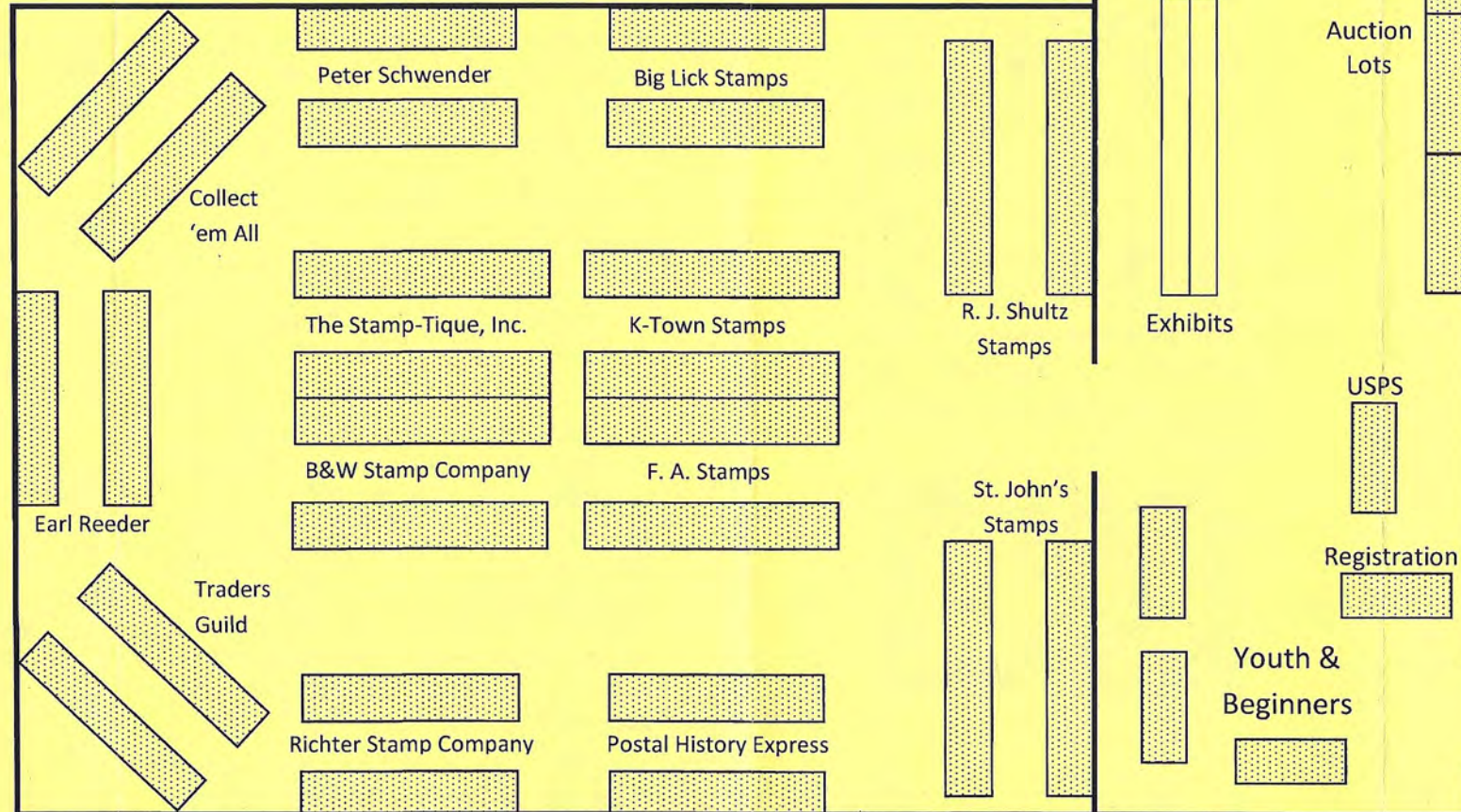
